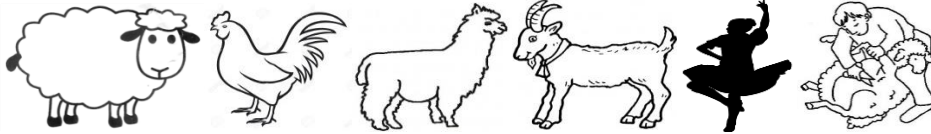


Dog Trials

The dog trials can be found at the East Street end of the showgrounds, by Drummond and Etheridge. At the dog trials, you can (over the two days of the show) see working dogs herd sheep.

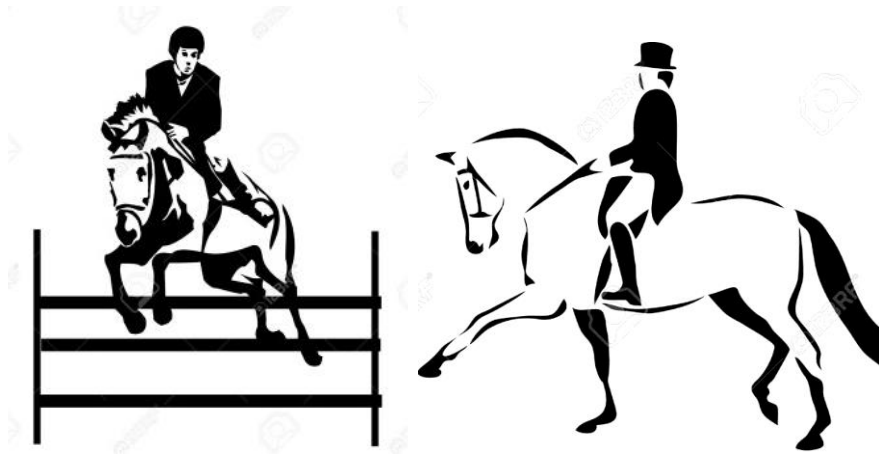
